GETTING TO THE MUSEUM

Parking:

TMA has a small **free** parking lot available to Museum patrons located on the corner of Washington Street and Meyer Avenue (across the street from Old Town Artisans).

Drop Off and Pick Up:

If you are coming via school bus we have a bus-loading zone located on Telles Street between Meyer Avenue and Court Street

Directions to the Museum:

The Tucson Museum of Art is located on the NE corner of Main St. & Alameda

From North:

Take Oracle (turns into Main Ave. and then Granada Ave) south past St. Mary's
Left at the light at Alameda
First left onto Main Avenue
Take first right on to Washington Street
Parking lot located at corner of Washington and Telles.

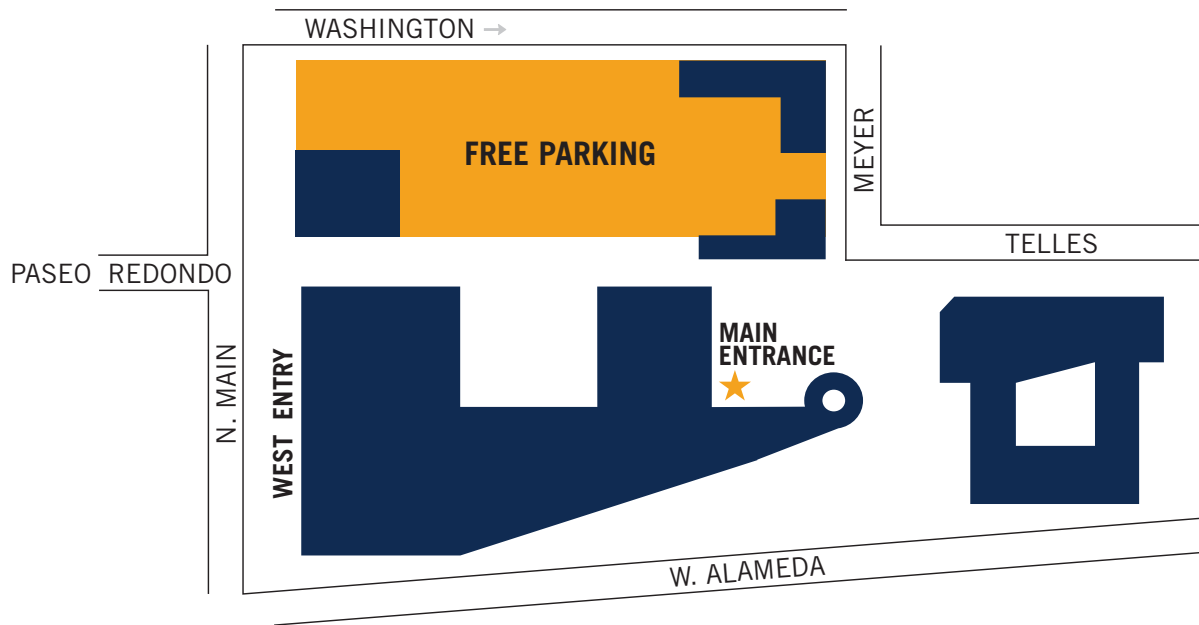
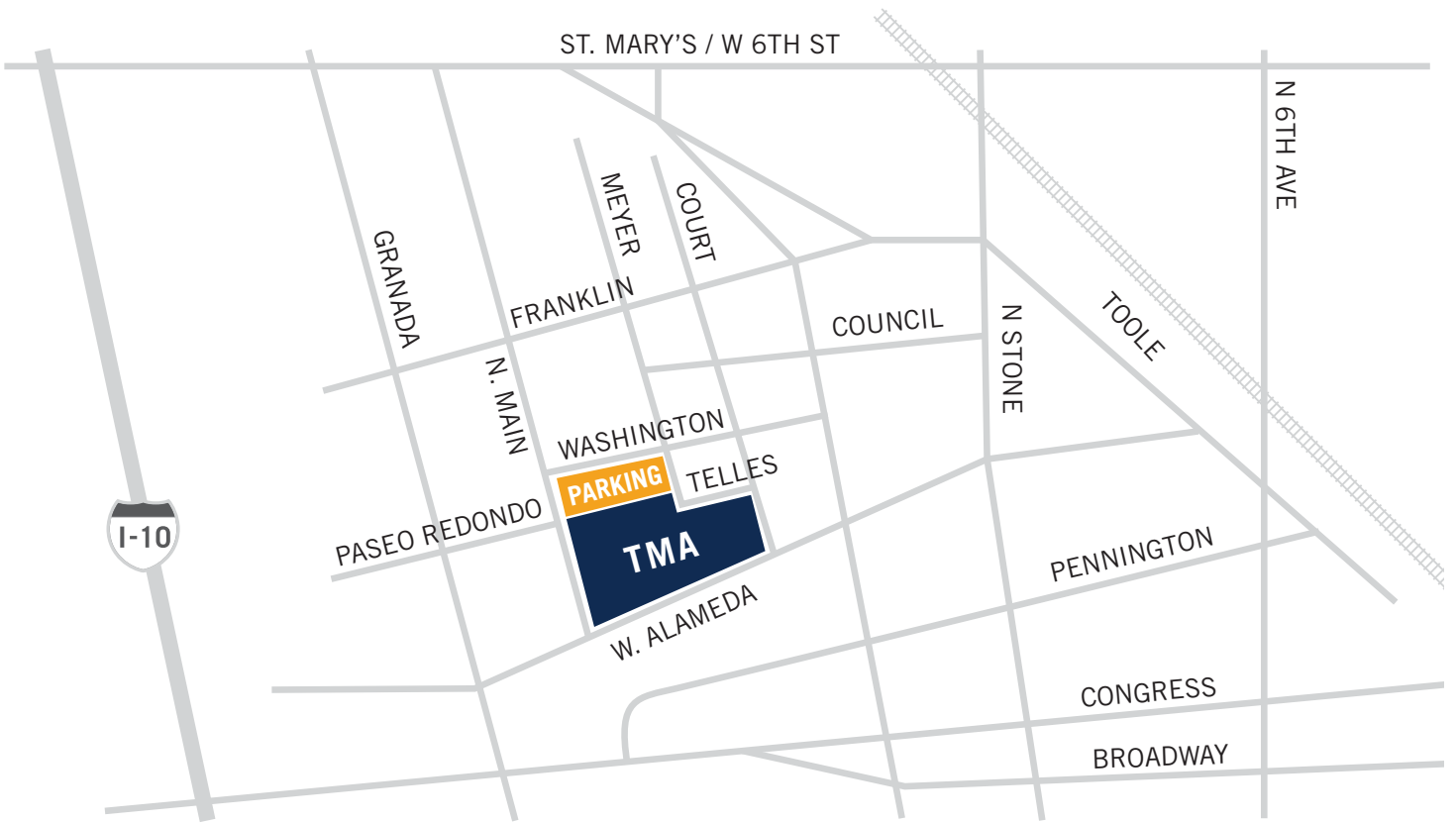
From East:

Speedway west to Stone Avenue
Head south on Stone to Alameda
Take Alameda west and make a right at Court Avenue.
Take first right on to Telles Street.
Parking lot located at corner of Telles and Washington.

Broadway west to Granada
Right on Granada
First right onto Alameda
First left onto Main Avenue
First right onto to Washington Street
Parking lot located at corner of Washington and Telles.

From I-10 or From West:

Exit to the East at Broadway/Congress exit
Take the first left at Granada
First right onto Alameda
First left onto Main Avenue
First right onto to Washington Street
Parking lot located at corner of Washington and Telles.

PREPARING FOR YOUR VISIT

Museum Manners:

Teachers, to ensure a meaningful and enjoyable experience for all of our visitors, we ask that you review the following guidelines with your students and chaperones.

- Be respectful and considerate.
- Touching harms the art, even clean hands leave oils or dirt behind.
- Please respect the art by giving it space and keep a safe distance between you and the works of art.
- Please help to keep our walls, pedestals, and artworks safe and clean by not leaning against them.
- Use pencils while in the Museum.
- Respect other groups and visitors in the Museum by using inside voices.
- Stay with your guide or chaperone.
- Large backpacks, bags or purses must be checked or left on the bus.
- Leave all food and drinks in your backpack or in the Museum lobby.
- Photography (non-flash) is welcome in the permanent collection galleries
