

## UAMA Tour Information

**Reservations are required for bus parking, call 520-621-3710 well in advance of your tour. Buses may drop off on Helen street and students can follow the pedestrian underpass to the UAMA.**

The Museum has no dining facilities — outdoor picnicking is available in nearby campus areas or buy lunches at the Student Union or University Blvd. eateries.

### All Group Tours:

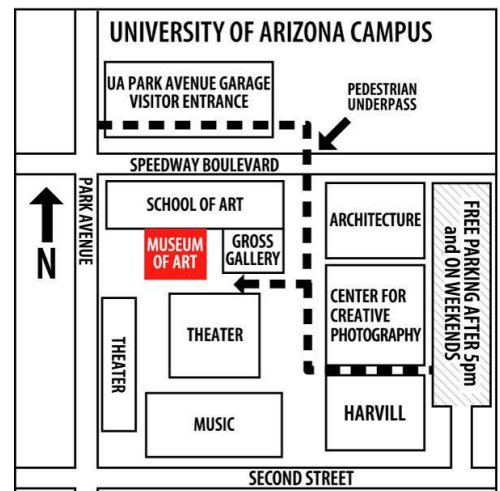
- K-12 groups require one adult chaperone per 10 students.
- Chaperones are expected to be active participants during the visit and help remind students to behave safely in the galleries, follow museum guidelines, and stay engaged with the group.
- Chaperones must stay with their group during the entire visit.
- Only graphite pencils may be used for writing or sketching in galleries.
- Backpacks, large bags, and umbrellas must be stored in the lobby. Lockers are available.
- Chewing gum, eating food or drinking beverages, and smoking are NOT permitted in the Museum.
- Camera Usage: Check with security personnel for restrictions.

### Docent Led Tours:

- Prepare name tags--distribute them to students to wear while in the Museum.
- Arrive five minutes before the scheduled tour time.
- If delayed, call **(520) 621-7567** (docents will remain 15 minutes past scheduled arrival time, and replacement guides are not available).
