



Call for Recycled Materials & STEM Artists to be featured in Act One's Experience 3 Virtual Reality Field Trip

Act One is recruiting Recycled Materials & STEM Artists in the visual and performing arts to be featured in Experience 3 of *Arts Immersion™*, our Virtual Reality Field Trip program. Act One will collaborate with the selected artists to create a unique educational experience, using virtual reality technology, to serve students of Title I schools in grades 5th-12th.

History of Program

Launched in 2021, *Arts Immersion™* closes the arts equity gap in Arizona's Title I schools by overcoming economic, geographic, and logistical barriers to provide inspiring, engaging, and interactive virtual reality experiences that cultivate knowledge and appreciation of the arts and inspire creativity. Experience 3 Project Details:

3-5 artists will be chosen to be featured. The VR field trip is broken down into 3 “chapters”, each 8-10 minutes long. Each chapter will feature a different art form or artist. All chapters will tie together with a unifying theme.

Dates: Between January and March 2025, artists may be needed for 1-2 days of filming either on location or at ASU’s MIX Studio. The artist will also be required to make additional promotional appearances post-launch.

Compensation: \$500-1,000/day of filming, depending on time and location.
